A General Word on Cookies

Cookie files allow a web server to store information it needs on your computer and to retrieve that information to identify you in the future. A cookie is a tiny piece of text that is placed on your hard drive.

In Pay24-7 cookies are used to track sessions only and cannot cause any privacy issues whatsoever. They are a requirement to allow Pay24-7 to function properly and are not used for any other purpose. After the session ends Pay24-7 cookies are deleted from the server and browser.

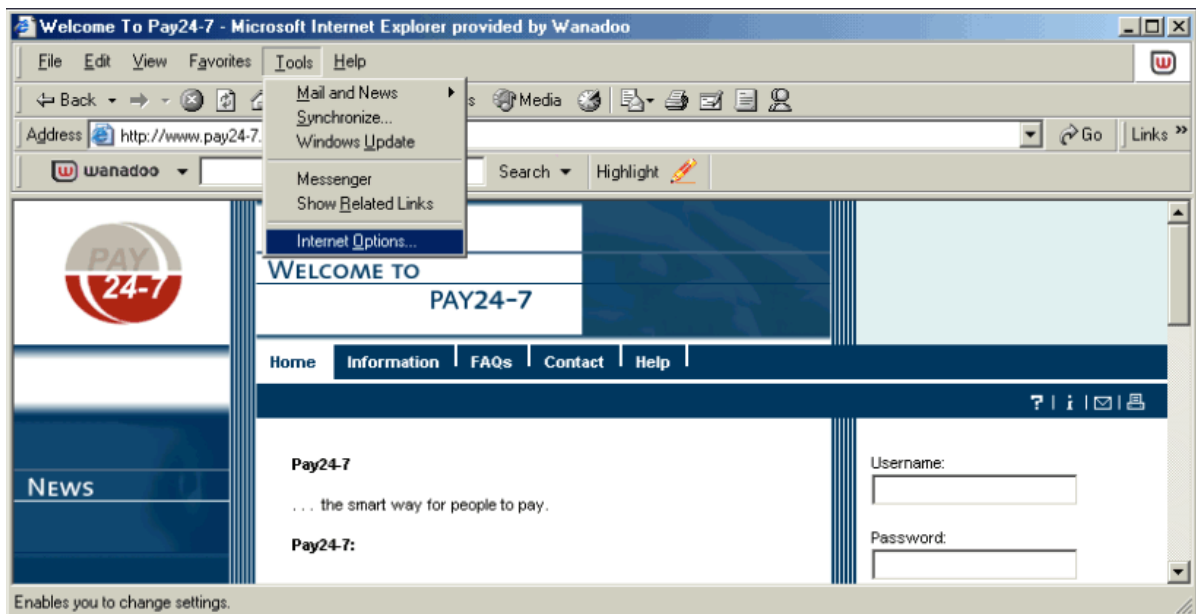
Pay24-7 will not function with browsers that don't support cookies.

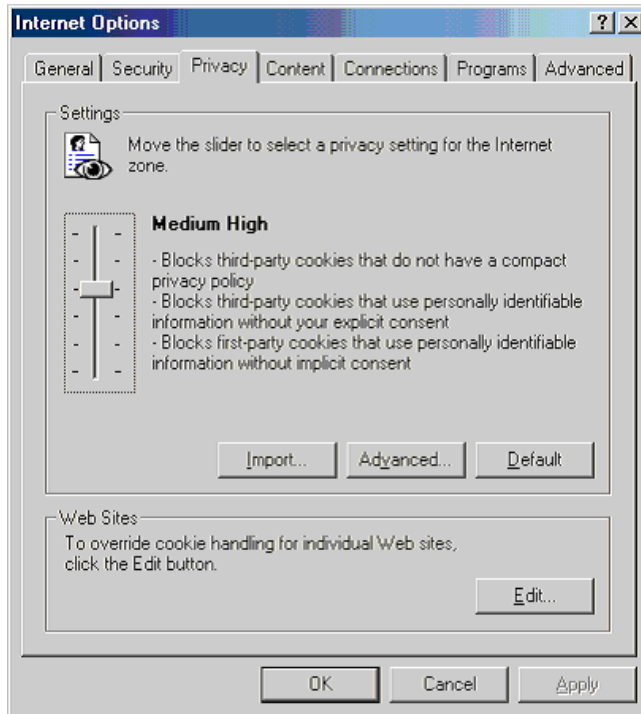
Below are some images to guide you through the process of enabling cookies.

The settings may vary slightly for different versions or platforms of Internet Explorer. Please make sure to close and restart your browser to enforce any changed settings.

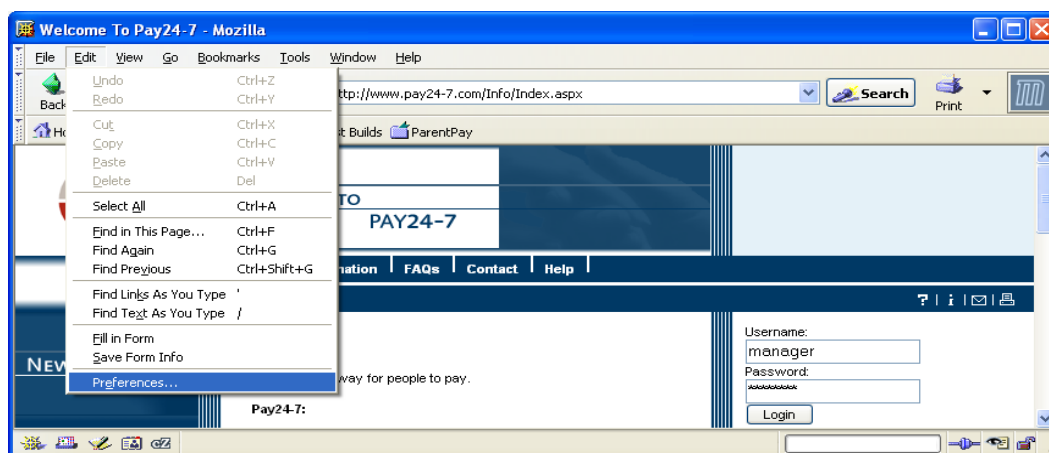


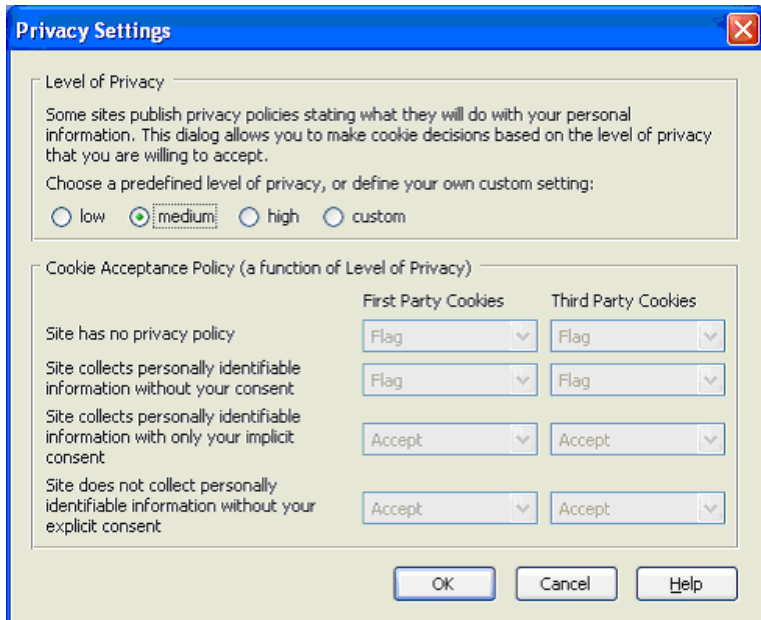
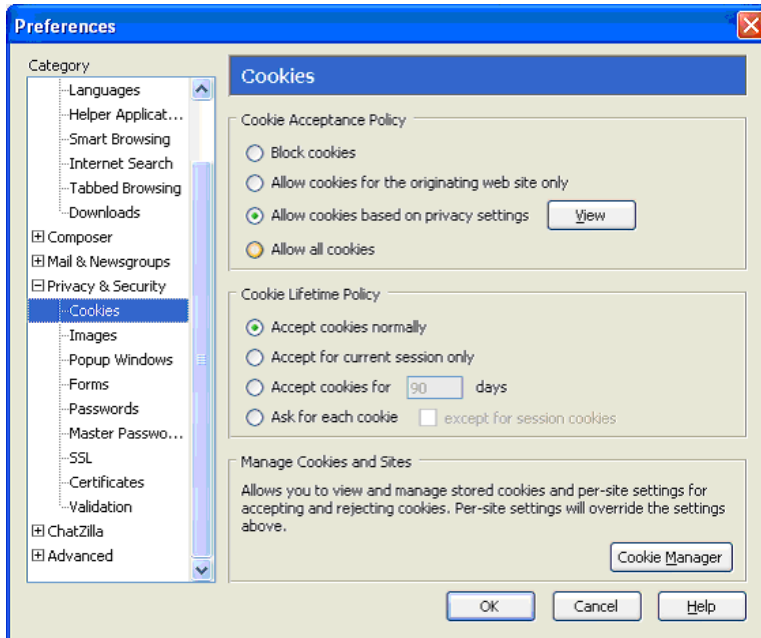
